Ash Wednesday, February 14, and Good Friday, March 29, are days of fast and abstinence. Fasting is defined as one full meal and two smaller meals, with nothing in between, for those aged 18 – 59. Water and medication are not a part of fasting.



Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence. Abstinence is not eating meat, for those aged 14 and older.
